But there were also positive impacts, especially for the vintage, which is positive for the economical situation of the country. The growing number of economical co-operations with western companies advances the traditional agriculture and the economical growth of the eastern countries.

Consequently it is always a question of the perspective how positive or negative a hot summer and its consequences can be experienced.

May we all benefit from challenging and difficult stages in our lives – relying upon God and his sovereign actions and by gainful handling with the situations.

The period between seed and harvest is quite long. The time of harvest is connected to heavy work and is often a race against time.

For the Israelites it was a loud celebration – a Thanksgiving. Most of us live in countries where it is hard to recognize when it is spring or autumn. There are always different types of fruit, vegetables and bread in all different colors and sizes. This is a reason to thank and praise God for his grace. But looking at the fields in Moldova and Germany I see a big difference. While we are having a large crop they are experiencing a poor harvest. Causes are partially – but not completely – lying in the ability and action of the people.

Watching the people working on the fields I always think of the “big harvest” the bible is talking about and mankind is waiting for. According to the bible each one of us will stand in front of God and will be taken into responsibility.

But there is another analogy in the figurative sense, which is the growth process and ripening of the children taking part at the christian summer camps. Bashfully and insecure they get confronted with this new and unfamiliar topic. They ask many questions regarding God and faith: What does it mean to pray? How do you pray? Is it allowed to read the bible? An many more. After many years you can watch these young people working as staff members with other christian youth groups. Spiritual growth had taken place – a process which was initiated and guided by God himself.

We are assured that he'll care for the growing of the fruits as well.
